GCSU Merit Awards

Up to ten merit awards will be presented to full-time undergraduate students who, in the opinion of their peers, have contributed to the quality of student life at Grenfell Campus through involvement in student union activities, clubs and societies, caucuses, and athletics. Award winners must have a cumulative academic average of not less than 65%.

Arthur M. Sullivan Award

The Arthur M. Sullivan Award will be presented to a full-time undergraduate student at Grenfell Campus who, in the opinion of their peers, has contributed to the quality of student life through involvement in their student union activities, clubs and societies, caucuses, and athletics. In addition, the recipient must be strong academically, having a cumulative academic average of not less than 70%. The recipient is an outstanding student who is successful in both their academics and participation in student life at Grenfell Campus.

Students are nominated for both awards through one application that must include a letter (approx. 250 words) outlining campus involvement and one (1) letter of support from either a fellow student, faculty, staff or community organization representative. Students can apply themselves or nominate a fellow student for these awards. The recipient of the Arthur M. Sullivan Award will be chosen from the group of applications.

The merit award recipients will receive a certificate. The Arthur M. Sullivan Award winner will receive \$250.00, a certificate, and their name engraved on the annual cup. The GCSU President, on the recommendation of the GCSU Awards Committee, presents the Merit and Sullivan Awards.
